Sexual Abuse and Assault Program

Our goal is to restore survivors of sexual abuse and assault to emotional health through education and treatment.

St. Francis Counseling Service is the designated provider in the county specializing in treatment of sexual assault and child sexual abuse.

Short-term therapy for sexual abuse and assault is available to all residents of Ocean County at 8 sites by our Master's level clinicians certified in EMDR and Sand Play therapies. Services are grant funded, therefore there is no cost to the client.

Community education programs on sexual violence and consent are available upon request.

Counseling

Affordable individual, family, couples and group therapy is available to all residents of southern Ocean County on a sliding-scale fee based on annual household income.

Trauma-informed therapists treat depression, anxiety, grief, trauma, relationship conflict and more.

The therapist is trained to help people make desired changes, including helping clients:

- Find new ways to look at problems
- Find new ways to behave
- Find new support systems
- Learn new information
- Find new sources of help
